Key areas of spending for Sports Premium Funding

- Funding towards school mini bus by the end of the year in order for Mears Ashby pupils to travel together and easily to sport venues.
- Mears Ashby football kit for future teams by the end of the year.
- Mears Ashby to seek further Real PE training to support PE curriculum.
