*Our topic is MEMORY BOX.*

### English

We will read traditional tales and poems that contain suffixes and prefixes. We will be writing our own poems. We will talk about the poems and traditional tales we are reading thinking what could happen next and why things have happened and we will answer questions about what we have read. We sequence events that have happened within a story.

### Maths

This term we will be focusing on counting in multiples of 5 to 50, reading and writing words to fifteen. We will be subtracting and solving problems that involve subtraction skills. We will be learning number bonds to 20 and related subtraction facts. We will continue to learn to recognise and know the volume of different coins and notes.

### Science

In science we will be learning about materials. We will look at everyday materials, we will describe them and look at their different properties. We will look at different objects and the materials they are made from. We will observe seasonal changes as we transition from winter to spring.

### ICT

We will continue to develop our coding skills using discovery education's coding program we will be completing unit 1B, simple inputs. This can be accessed from home on a PC, laptop or tablet.

### RE and PSHE

In RE we will be learning about places of worship focusing on the Christian faith, therefore we will be looking at the different features of a church. In PSHE we will be learning what is meant by a healthy lifestyle, including the benefits of physical activity, rest, healthy eating, dental health and emotional health.

### Geography and History

We will be looking at the physical features of the seaside and seaside holidays from the past.

### D&T

In D&T we will be learning about food hygiene, thinking about having good hygiene skills before cooking. We will make and decorate cupcakes for Mother's Day. We will look at different tastes and textures using adjectives to describe these. We will talk about our favourite sandwich fillers, design and make our own sandwiches.

### PE

This term during PE we will be continuing to develop our dance skills in preparation for the festival of dance in March. We will then choreograph our own dances for the festival this year's theme is the beach.

### Music

In music we will be continuing to make different rhythms with percussion instruments and singing songs and rhymes.
