Ingleborough Hall reminder

Dear Parent,

On Monday morning your child will need to bring a packed lunch (unless they are on free school meals). Even if your child is on free meals please send an extra drink and snack. Please do not send glass bottles or fizzy drinks. Due to one of our children having a nut allergy please **do not send any nuts or nut products.**

You need to bring your child to school at the usual time, before 9am, and bring their suitcase to the small hall. We aim to be leaving at 9:15am.

If your child needs medicine whilst at Ingleborough, or you know they are travel sick, you must put their medication in a named bag with instructions and hand it to either Mrs Birkinshaw or Miss Nero.

We will be doing our first activity as soon as we get to Ingleborough so your child needs to be dressed in suitable clothing (no jeans) Jogging bottoms are best.

Please put their hat, scarf, gloves and a thick pair of socks in their rucksack and not in the suitcase as they will need them as soon as we get there.

Don't forget to give your child some 20 pence's in their £5 if you want them to ring home. Make sure you have included the phone number you want to be rung on. If your phone has a call barring for unknown numbers please remove, or give your child an alternative number to ring.

On Friday we will be back in school at 2:45pm and **your child must be collected by an adult from the school hall.**
