## SCHOOL CLOSURE

Our decision to close the school is such a hard one to make. It is made on the basis of safety for pupils and for staff. We have to take into account that the majority of our teachers have to travel a considerable distance, and on roads that were closed for some time with a few crashes and abandoned cars. If staff cannot get there safely, or have to leave, then this is not safe for pupils to be successfully monitored and looked after either. Not all of our pupils live in Hessle, and many of our parents drive. Many factors and limited time to make a decision—and who knew we were still so bad at accurately predicting the weather.

So thank you once again and here's hoping we won't have to be thinking about closing anytime soon. On a positive note we do hope that the children had a lovely time playing in the snow, as, lets be honest, the chances we have to do so are very rare these days.
