### 2. Interviews for staff

We spoke about what an interview is. Kyle, Archie, Lily and Mark said they would be interested in being involved in the interviews. I asked what they would want in a good worker and Kyle wrote:

- To be listened to and to value other people's feelings and thoughts without being judged or made to feel uncomfortable.

- Do you have a valid driving license/have you ever been caught by the police?
- Will you listen to me and do what's best for me?

- Have you had specific training to our medical and health needs?
- Are you good with kids?
- How did you get to the job?
- Would you help me?
- Are you a fun person?
- Are you bias?
- How would you be working here?
