Thank you for your patience and understanding during the closure. It was an extremely difficult decision to make but the safety of all our staff, children and families was of utmost importance.

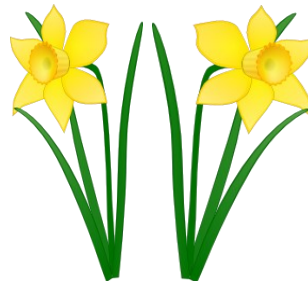
