Thank you to The Friends Association for their donation towards the painting easel for the Reception classroom. This is very much appreciated and is being put to good use.

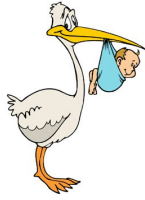
### **Easter Prize Bingo—Change of Date**

Everyone is welcome to join us and support the fund raising of the Friends Association.

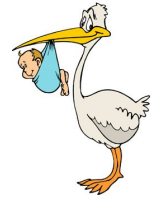
### **Earrings**
