Literacy

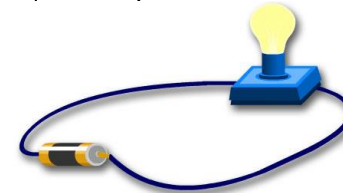
Fiction Focus: Children will read a range of poems and then use personification and imagery to create their own
