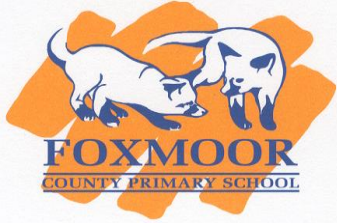

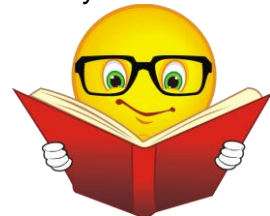
Netball
