School Club Participation

A variety of physical activity after school clubs have continued to be offered to all KS1 and 2 pupils. These were run by 2 members of staff, Ben Newson and Josh Harrison in the Summer Term (allowing more children to participate) and from Autumn 2016 Ben Newson has run the clubs. There has been an increase in the number of children wanting to take part and all the school based clubs offered in the Autumn and Spring Term have a waiting list. The children participate enthusiastically during the clubs and are keen to continue to practice their skills at other times. The children have a very positive attitude towards any matches played against other schools. The increase in the number of clubs on offer has had an impact on the numbers of pupils accessing physical activity outside the curriculum including a Holiday Sports Club.
