St Patricks Disco Friday 16th March:

- Few tickets remaining – alert/text to be sent 09/03/18 to parents
- Pricing of games – Lucky Dip to remain at 20p, all other games 30p a go or 4 for £1. Glow sticks priced at 20p each or 3 for 50p. Transfer Tattoos priced at 50p each.
- Tuck shop – Chocolate bars to be reduced to 20p each, all other prices to remain the same. Need more Haribo and crisps- **Helen T** to buy.
- 3x 24 boxes of cup drinks – **Helen T** to buy 2x boxes, enough coca cola and diet coke in stock, 8x cans of Sprite **Helen T** to buy another pack of both Sprite and Sprite Zero.
- Enough Coca Cola and Diet Coke in stock. Helen T to buy more cup drinks, water and Sprite, Prosecco, Beer and Rose wine
- Chilli – **Helen T** and **Sarah A** - cater for 50 adults. Jacket Potatoes – 5 volunteers to cook 10 each- **Helen T, Helen S, Joanna, Lizzie and Keeley** to do this. Hotdogs cater for 78 children. **Helen T** to buy all items. **Helen T** Mother in law making vegetarian chilli for 6 just in case.
- Shopping to be delivered to school on Tuesday 13th March. Potatoes to go to volunteers on Thursday 15th March.
- Prizes for games – stickers/individually wrapped sweets/90 Swizzle’s lollies in stock – **Helen T** to buy more to have 200
- **Helen S** to bring her Prosecco fridge
- **Helen T** to buy raffle tickets
- Setting up- work around Karate After school club (on til 4.30pm) **Helen T and Joanna** plus **Helen S and Maria** if required. Decorations are balloons/bunting/shamrocks for on tables/hanging decorations. Agreed this was enough. Set up Tuck shop in Class 3 until after Keys Club.
- **Mrs Shaw** to sort the floats for 11 stalls as per agenda.

Quiz - Friday 27th April 2018:

- 6 rounds of 10 questions – 3 rounds, a break with a picture round then a further 3 rounds. Topics are TV, Film, Sport, General Knowledge, School, Intro’s.

- Joanna has suggested a Number card instead of raffle to prevent mithering for prizes. Each number square is sold for a set amount and then a cash prize as the winnings.

- No food to be served. Snacks only.

- **Lizzie** to approach local Micro Breweries re a Pop Up bar instead of having a FOSP bar. Soft drinks will need to be sold by FOSP.
- **Bradley** to sort licence for both bar and sale of tickets

Summer Fair - Saturday 7th July 2018:

- All agreed this needed its own meeting as too much to discuss with only 4 members present.
- Helen S confirmed that after May Half term there will be 3 Non Uniform days on a Friday where bottles/chocolates/card tombola toys will be asked for each Friday.
- Raffle tickets to be pre-sold for the bigger prizes
- **Joanna** to arrange the raffles – contacting local businesses/parents businesses for prizes. Confirmed so far are: 1 day at Olly's Woodland Learning Holiday club, 5 nights @ Keys Club, 2 x tablets.
- **Helen S** will advertise Summer Fair and FOSP meeting on Newsletter after Easter to raise awareness and to emphasise the need for helpers.
