An E-safety reminder for parents

We ran an E-Safety workshop recently, (details of which can be found on our website under the 'Parents' Page') where parents talked about the constant stream of new APPs which are available to children.

We suggest the following actions to help:

- Use either **Apple Family Sharing** or **Google Play Family Library** so that you have control over which APPs your child can access.
- Talk to your child and show as much interest as possible in the APPs being used.
- If your child wants to upload video clips, talk to them about their reasons, check the content and ensure they are not sharing any personal information whilst doing so.
- We are aware of problems around children using APPs like 'Muscially' and 'Party in the dorm' where people can suggest they post video clips of themselves. Please check the age limit on all of the APPs – some are designed for adult use i.e. dating.

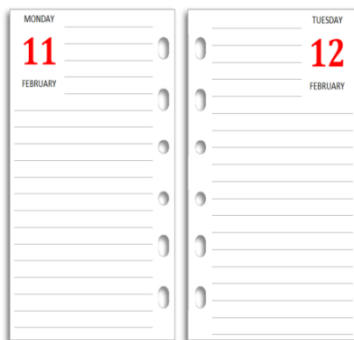
If you have any concerns or questions about the ways children can stay safe on the internet, please speak to Mr Nesbitt.
