We look forward to seeing you at this important evening which provides you with an opportunity to discuss your child's progress and development with their class teacher. Thank you for your continued support.

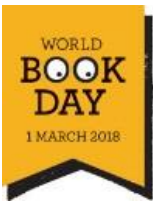
World Book Day Dress Up Day

We really do appreciate the time and effort taken by parents/carers to come up with such fantastic creations.

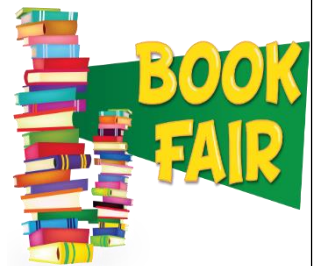
