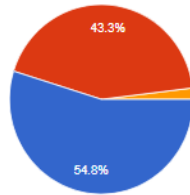

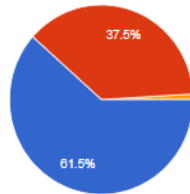

My child feels safe at school.

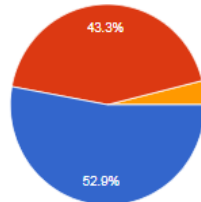

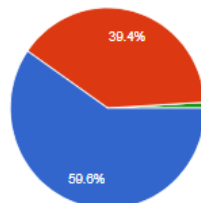

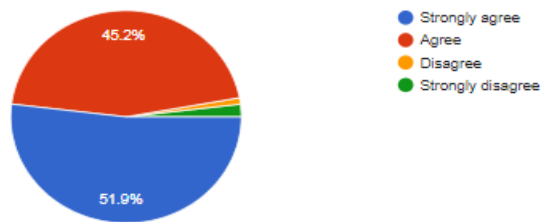

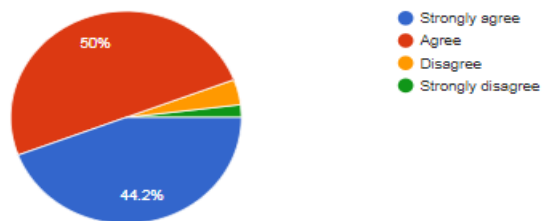
My child is challenged at school and achieves well.

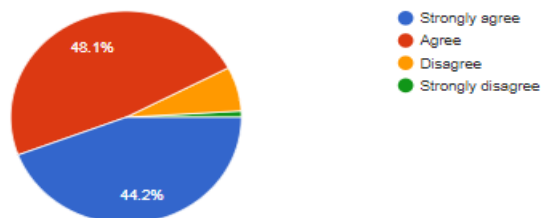
I understand what my child is being taught at school.

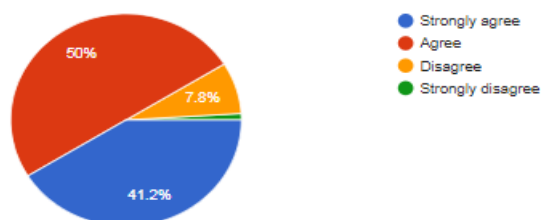

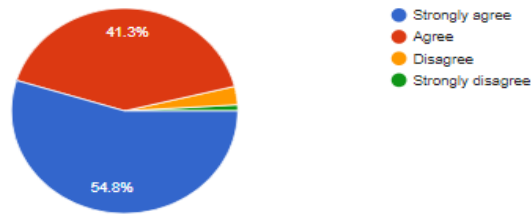

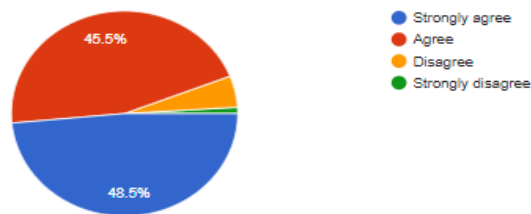

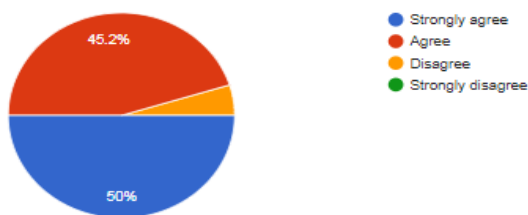

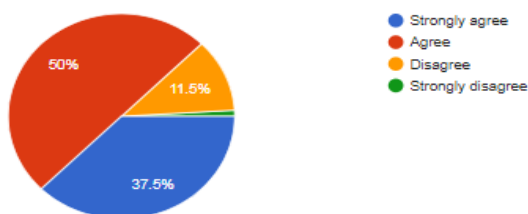

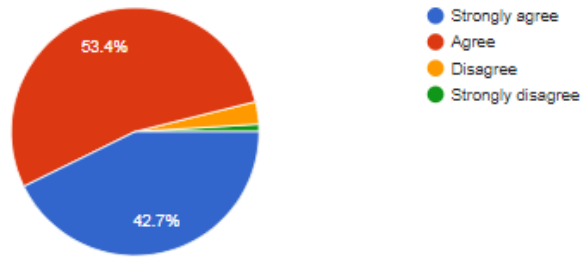

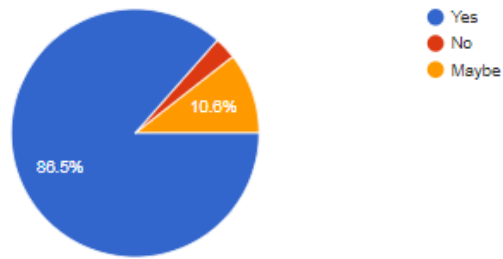
