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Sports Premium Funding Impact Report 2016 -2017

Background

The school received £8220 (August 2016 - July 2017), from the Department for Education to improve the quality of P.E and sport for all children at FitzHerbert C of E (VA) Primary school.

The impact of the Primary PE and Sports funding must highlight an increase in the participation, standards, attainment and progress of all pupils. Additionally, it should encourage pupils to develop healthy lifestyles and support children in reaching the performance levels that they are capable of.

It is expected that schools will see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - kick starting healthy active lifestyles
2. The profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
3. Increase the confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in the teaching of PE and sport
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
5. Increased participation in competitive sport.

Review:

Events entered: multiskills, Y5/6 Hockey, whole school cross country, Y5/6 SSP cross country championship, basketball, orienteering, football

Clubs delivered: hockey, fencing, multiskills, tennis, football, hi 5s, running, athletics, kwik cricket, rounders and dodgeball

Staff CPD: ASA swimming course, lifeguard training,

Special events: Sports week - including horse riding, zorbing and archery. Sports Night, sponsored mile and Tai Chi

Awards: Sainsbury's School Games Silver, we came 2nd in the basketball competition and JW came 3rd overall in Y5/6 SSP cross country championship.
