## Spring Term Highlights

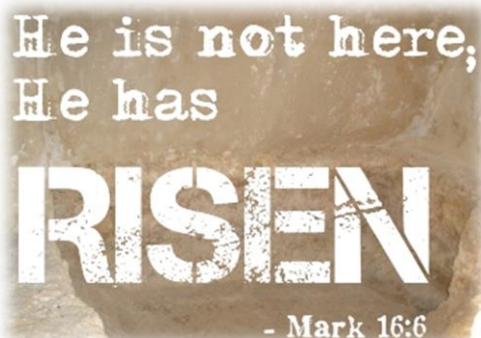
As always, we have had an extremely busy term but what a fantastic few weeks it has been! Below are just a few of the many highlights of the term:
