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- **Staffing**

We have had a number of staff absent through illness this term. We have plans in place to cover this but it always causes some inconsistency to the provision we can offer the children and I apologise if your child has been affected by this.

There have also been staffing issues in Year 3. I had hoped that we had dealt with this but unfortunately I had to let Miss King go. Again I am trying different teachers to find a person who shares the same high standards of work and behaviour as the rest of the staff at Norbriggs who can teach Year 3 for the summer term.

The situation will be resolved in September when Mrs Ward returns from maternity leave. Again, I can only apologise to the parents and children in Year 3 for the inconsistency they have experienced this year and thank you for your patience and support whilst we attempt to solve this issue.

- **School Funding**

We have set the budget for the next financial year and I am pleased to say that, although it is very tight, we will not need to make any staffing cuts this year. We have 2 small classes, Reception and Year 4, going through the school and, although this is good for adult to pupil ratio, it does reduce the amount of money the school gets quite substantially.

- **Fund Raising**

Mrs Richardson, Mrs Otter and the fund raising team are doing a fantastic job at bringing money into the school. Last term we received £1,000 from Tesco and £10,000 from the National Lottery. We also have money from last year's fund raising activities and the Local Authority have match funded some of our proposed projects. We are at the end stage of agreeing quotes so you should see where that money is being spent very soon. The planned areas for improvement are the Nursery playground, Reception outdoor area and the mud patch by the main gate on the playground.

We have already raised more money this year which will go towards the next round of improvements.

All money raised through fund raising is spent directly on items that benefit the children so we thank you all for your support and generosity.

- **School Sign**

Thankyou to everybody who sent ideas in for the new school sign and logo. The designers are working with your ideas and once we are happy with it we will get it installed.

- **Uniform and Behaviour**

I have been reminding children that if they wear trainers to school they must be black. They have been listening and I hope you agree that our children do look much smarter.

I have also been clamping down on silly behaviour and the message seems to be getting through that we have all had enough of name calling and aggressive behaviour. On the whole behaviour is good and I am determined to keep it that way.

- **Holidays**

Just a reminder that as we approach the summer term and the warmer weather I am still unable to authorise absence from school for a holiday. If your child's attendance after their holiday falls below 94% we have no choice but to refer the absence to the Local Authority who may impose a fine.
