## Data Protection

On 25th May, new Data Protection legislation will come into force which will impact upon the day-to-day activities of schools. In preparation, we are reviewing our Data Protection Policy, Privacy Statements and working practices. The changes will mean that we will need to ask all families to sign amended permission forms. We will also need to make sure that you always know why we are requesting information from you, how we intend to use it and how long we will keep it on file.

Safeguarding your child, and preserving your privacy, are amongst the key aims of the new legislation. Therefore, your ongoing support of our policies regarding the restricted sharing of names and images (at events such as public performances and Summer Fun Day) is a much-appreciated and highly-protective action.
