usual maths, writing and other great learning. We celebrated our success in worship. Well done to team 5 who were the winners led by Emily and Joe.

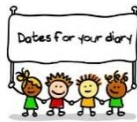
Don’t forget, sport can make a difference – you can learn new skills, make new friends, it builds confidence and is fun!
