Terms and conditions for parents and children attending extended school activities.

Please note:

- We are committed to providing high quality after school activities for your child to enjoy.
- Some of our activities are run and organised by outside providers and will not involve school staff.
- It is therefore imperative that these terms and conditions are adhered to.

Aims and objectives;

- To provide your child with regular, high quality activities after school in a safe, secure and happy environment.

Registration:

- You will be required to apply for a place at an extended school activity on behalf of your child by completing a permission slip.
- A registration form must be returned before your child is able to participate in the extended school activity.
- You will be informed if your child has been allocated a place.

Payment

- **All payments are required with the registration form.**
- Failure to do so will result in your child forfeiting their place at the after school activity.
- This will entitle your child to a place at the club for 6 sessions; you will be notified of these dates in advance of the first session.

Collection

- All children must be collected from the main entrance at 4.30pm.
- All children must be collected by an adult over the age of 16.
- Children must be collected promptly at the end of the session. In the event of any delay, please telephone the school office on 780246 prior to 2.30pm.
- Please remember that all children must use the pedestrian walkways.

Behaviour

- Our aim is that every child enjoys the after school activities that they attend and value the commitment demonstrated by our providers.
- We expect the school's high expectations and standards of attitude and behaviour to extend to all extended school activities on offer.
- Parents and carers will be informed if these standards are not met and this could result in your child forfeiting their place at the extended school activity.
- **Participation in all extended school activities is dependent on your child's behaviour and attitude during the normal school day, if they do not meet our high expectations they may forfeit their place.**
