Children using SeeSaw

As you may be aware, the school has invested in 120 iPads to enhance our teaching and learning. Alongside this investment, we have registered each child onto a digital platform known as 'SeeSaw'. The SeeSaw Application (App) is a fantastic resource which enables the children to store their work, in particular capturing work that cannot be recorded within their books. This term the children have begun to use SeeSaw in their lessons to upload videos, drawings, notes and photos of their work.

With this school newsletter, your child should have also brought home another sheet with instructions on how you can download the 'SeeSaw Parent' App, free of charge, and keep up to date with their learning in school. The App is available on all Apple and Android devices.

On this sheet there is a QR code which you can scan and will take you directly to your child's account. This QR code is unique to your child to keep confidentiality. By downloading the App you will be able to keep up to date with your child's learning, look at work they have completed in school together and like and comment on their work. More importantly, it will help parents be able to discuss with their children what they are learning at school.

By using this software, we hope to strengthen pupil, teacher and parent relationships by allowing parents to access and really play a part in their child's learning. We hope that you download the app and join us on this exciting journey.

Downloading the app and getting started is very easy. However, if you have any problems downloading the app on your device, please contact the school to book a time for one of our IT technicians to assist you.

Planes, Trains and Automobiles - Y3 Visit to Sheffield



Please ensure that if your child does suffer from travel sickness that they have taken their tablet before coming to school to avoid distress on our journey. If your child requires a tablet for the return journey please send it in an envelope labeled with your child's name and clear instructions as to when it should be taken.

A packed lunch will be required, (no glass bottles please), although if your child has free school meals a packed lunch will be provided by school. School uniform should be worn along with a waterproof coat and comfortable shoes.

No spending money is required for the trip.

The children will walk to the bus stop, travel by bus to the train station, take the train to Sheffield and travel by tram to the centre of Sheffield where they will visit the Winter Gardens and the Peace Gardens.
