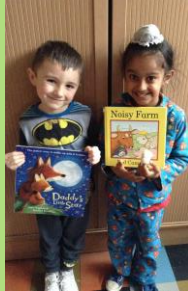
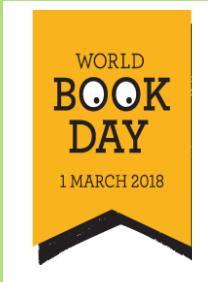


Foundation Newsletter
