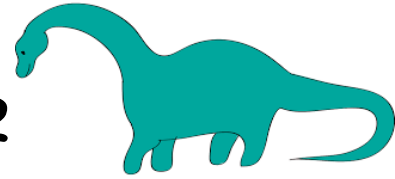
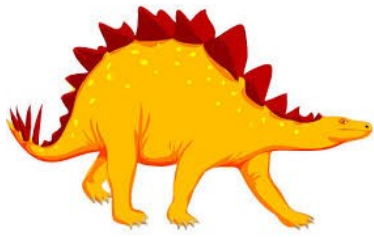

April 2018 Summer Term 2



Our topic is Dinosaur Discovery

English

This term we will continue to focus on using our phonics in preparation for the year 1 phonics check. We will go on a learning to learn Dinosaur adventure. We will be learning to read and spell the year 1 common exception words. We will read information texts and stories about dinosaurs. We will be writing in sentences about different dinosaurs and their features. We will talk about the stories we are reading thinking what could happen next and why things have happened and we will answer questions about what we have read.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on counting forwards and backwards, reading and writing numbers to 100. We will be counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will be adding and solving problems that involve adding and subtraction skills. We will continue to learn to tell the time, measure length, height and weight and know the names of 3D shapes and British coins and notes.

Science

In science we will be learning about the living things. We will look at different habitats of living things and we will learn about carnivores, omnivores and herbivores.

ICT

We will be developing our coding skills using discovery education's coding program. This can be accessed from home on a PC, laptop or tablet.

RE

In RE we will be learning about the Jewish faith. We will learn about the festivals of Pesach and Shavuot.

Geography and History

In geography we will continue to look at different geographical features and learn about the Isle of Coll in Scotland.

In History we will learn about Mary Anning and how she discovered fossils and dinosaur remains. Then we will continue to look at history of the seaside.

D+T and Art

In D+T and Art we will carry out dinosaur activities. We will work with Tan as part of the work towards this term's special week Shelton Sculpts.

PE

This term during PE we will be developing games skills. We will increase control in aiming, throwing and catching. We will look at different ways of traveling, balancing and jumping in Gymnastics.

In music we will be making different rhythms with percussion instruments and singing songs and rhymes about dinosaurs and the seaside.

We will also be going on a school trip to Drayton Manor on Wednesday 16th May to learn all about Dinosaurs and going on the rides at Thomas Land!

Please try to hear your child read their book and learn their words read 3 times a week and write in their reading diary.
