Dear Parents

Next term we would like to take the Y4 children away on an overnight visit to Youlgreave in the Peak District. We hope to base the whole of the summer term's work around the visit which will include a river study and a village study.

The overnight visit will give us more time to work in the area. It will also give your child a chance to experience a different environment, to share the excitement of being away with their peer group and to enjoy a little structured independence.

We will leave at 9.15 am on Tuesday 8th May, staying overnight at the village Youth Hostel and returning at approximately 3.15 pm on Wednesday 9th May.

We have arranged a meeting for parents on Tuesday 17th April at 6.00 pm when we will explain more about the visit and will give out packing lists, etc.

There is no specialist equipment required for the visit; old warm clothing is most suitable as we shall be spending most of our time outdoors. In order to fund the visit we will require contributions of £60.00 which helps towards the cost of accommodation, meals and transport. Full amounts or instalments accepted as soon as possible, please. 50% remission is automatically available for parents who are entitled to Pupil Premium (if you have received income support at any point in the past six years) but no child will be excluded from visits through an inability to pay even the 50%.

If you have any difficulty with payment, then please do not let it prevent your child from going, just come in and see us and we may be able to help.
