



2016/17 Key Stage Two Assessment Results

At the end of Key Stage 2 in Year 6 pupils are assessed using nationally designed tests. The tests are scored and pupils are given a 'scaled score' which compares their performance to an expected standard of 100 and a higher standard of 110.

Writing – Teacher Assessment

Pupils are also assessed by their teacher against criteria for an expected standard in writing and a greater depth standard. This is based on lots of independent writing over a period of time and the teacher's judgements are moderated externally.

Reading, Writing and Maths combined

Pupils are meeting the expected standard if they achieve a scaled score of 100 or more in their reading and maths tests, and their teacher assesses them as 'working at the expected standard' or better in Writing.

Pupils are achieving at a higher standard if they achieve a scaled score of 110 or more in their reading and maths tests, and their teacher assesses them as 'working at a greater depth within the expected standard' in Writing
