- Independent reading
- Begin to practice handwriting skills.
- To say out loud what they are going to write about.
- Begin to write simple sentences with capital letters, full stop and spaces.
- To re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense.
- To become familiar with, retell and consider the particular characteristics of stories
- To predict what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far.
- To recognise and join in with predictable phrases.
- To discuss what they have written with the teacher or other children.
