School Dinners

If you wish to pay by debit card please use the Tameside MBC website, otherwise please send the correct money to the school office in a sealed envelope with your child's name on the front, clearly stating what the money is for. **Dinner money needs to be paid on a Monday morning for that week's dinners, or in advance at the beginning of each half term.** ParentPay is currently unavailable for Dinner money.
