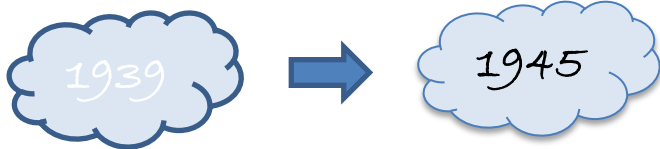

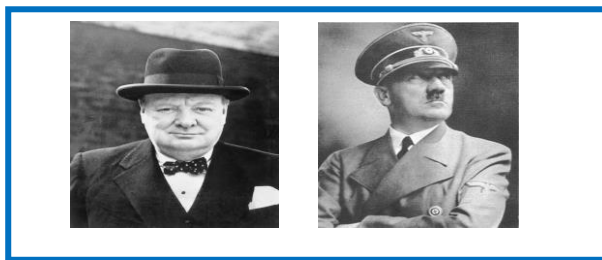

Winston Churchill	British Prime Minister 1940-1945
Adolf Hitler	Chancellor of Germany 1933-1945
Benito Mussolini	Prime Minister of Italy 1922-1943
Franklin Roosevelt	US President 1933-April 1945
Harry Truman	US President April 1945-1953
Anne Frank	A Jewish girl who was forced into hiding during WW2. Her diary shows the daily struggles people faced against the Nazi's.

Artefact	An object left as evidence of life in an earlier time
Evacuation	When children leave an area that might be dangerous and go somewhere safer to live
Rationing	When people are only allowed to purchase a fixed amount of food/goods
U-boat	German submarine
Air raid	Military aeroplanes sent to bomb an area
Shelter	A safe place to hide during an air raid
The Blitz	57 days of air raids in Britain (London)
Gas Mask	Protective mask to prevent breathing in of poisonous gases
Nazi	A German fighter
Concentration camp	A place where Hitler sent people he did not like
