Dear Parent/Carer,

As you are aware the school received a hoax bomb threat via the school email account this morning. We immediately contacted the police and the local authority emergency helpline for advice. They informed us that a large number of schools had received the email and that the police were treating it as a hoax threat.

The detective Chief Inspector Stuart Miller, Humberside Police has released the following statement:

“We’ve been made aware of a hoax email sent to schools in the force area this morning 13 April 2018.

“We want to categorically reassure parents and children, staff and the wider public that this a non-credible threat that has been sent nationwide.

“Our primary concern is to ensure that schools are given guidance, up-to-date information and reassurance and above all that everyone is safe.

“Community officers have already been sent to schools to provide that reassurance.”

The health and safety of the staff and children will remain our paramount concern. We will continue to work closely with the relevant authorities to ensure we are following all the recommended procedures and will seek advice as required.
