The new partition

I'm sure we would all agree that the safety of the children is our top priority. As explained in a previous newsletter, the new partition is designed to help keep your children safe and to make sure we know who is in school. Thank you for your co-operation with this as we all get used to this change.

If you do need to see your child's teacher, please bear in mind that in the mornings the teachers are busy preparing for the day's lessons and the imminent arrival of 30 children! If possible, please leave a message with the school office and the teachers will get back to you as soon as they can.

General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)

We are busy preparing for the new data protection law which is coming in on 25th May. This involves sending out a privacy notice to parents to ensure that you are aware of the data which we need to hold in order for us to meet the requirements which all schools have as data controllers. The policy will be available on the website by 25th May and the privacy notice will be sent out by the end of term. We will also need to get your consent again for photographs, website, media etc as we have updated the forms to comply with the new GDPR regulations.

We do not intend to prevent parents from taking photographs or videos at school events but, as ever, we do ask that these photographs are only for personal use and not posted on social media sites if they contain the image of other people's children, unless you have obtained parental consent to do so. The school would not be liable for a data breach in this situation but you could be breaching the privacy rights of those individuals.
