

Communication and Language

In Listening and Attention, the children will be learning to:

- Listen to and follow instructions
- Listen and do at the same time
- Listen to the views of others.

In Speaking, the children will be learning to:

- Introduce a storyline into their play.

In Understanding, the children will be learning to:

- Respond to a two part instruction
- Follow a story without pictures.

Literacy

In Reading, the children will be learning to:

- Recognise some common words
- Link sounds to letters
- Name and sound out the letters of the alphabet
- Read words and begin to read simple sentences
- Decode some regular words using all phonemes in set 1 and set 2 RWI.

In Writing, the children will be learning to:

- Continue to write their own name and simple words using pre-cursive handwriting
- Attempt to write words and short sentences in meaningful contexts.

Understanding the World

As part of Understanding the World, the children will be learning to:

- Use ICT hardware to interact with age-related computer software
- Look closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change.

Physical Development

In Health and Self-Care, the children will be learning to:

- Experiment with different ways of moving
- Negotiate space when playing racing and chasing games, adjust speed and change direction to avoid obstacles.

In Moving and Handling, the children will be learning to:

- Begin to use anticlockwise movement
- Improve scissor skills.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be learning to make relationships by learning to:

- Initiate conversations and take account of what others say
- Explain own knowledge and understanding
- Ask appropriate questions of others.

The children will be learning how to manage their feelings and behaviour by learning how to:

- Understand their own actions affect others
- Understand and follow rules
- Comfort other children when they are upset.
