On the occasions when the sun is strong it would be wise to apply some sun cream to your child's exposed skin and for them to come equipped with sun hat / sun glasses etc.

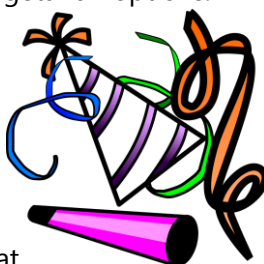
### **Royal Wedding Party Day**
