- Medical letters
- Copy of a prescription or medicine with official prescribed label

# **MEDICINES**

Please note that we can only administer medicine in school:

- If the dose is 4 times per day as written on the label from the pharmacy.
- The bottle must have the child's name and the date printed on the pharmacy label. We cannot give shop bought medicine.
- You must fill in a form at reception
- Only inhalers can be given to the class teacher for administration.

Being frequently late for school adds up to lost learning:

Arriving **5 minutes late** every day adds up to over **3 days** lost each year.

Arriving **15 minutes late** every day is the same as being absent for **2 weeks** a year.

Arriving **30 minutes late** every day is the same as being absent for **19 days** a year.
