We are very proud of the Nursery provision that we provide and believe that it gives a wonderful grounding to starting education. We offer 2.5 days provision from a Monday morning until a Wednesday lunchtime.

Our Nursery applications for the September 2018 intake have now closed and all those who have been offered a place have been notified. We will hold a waiting list for those interested in putting their name down, but all spaces have been filled.

To join us from September 2019

We shall be accepting applications from 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2018 – 31<sup>st</sup> January 2019 for September 2019 intake. It will be a first come, first served system with your form clearly dated when handed to the school office. If you have already returned an application form for this year, or future years, we shall honour it and contact you in due course. With immediate effect we will now no longer accept applications outside the September to January window for the following September start. This will help promote fairness to all and allow us to notify you when you hand in your form whether you have a guaranteed space.

Our nursery provision is for children who have turned three by 31<sup>st</sup> August for the following September. So, if your child turns three between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 - 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019 they are entitled to a nursery place from September 2019.
