I am pleased to be able to tell you that there is a great opportunity for parents to hear about online safety for children from someone who is a real expert and a very engaging speaker – Mr Karl Hopwood, an ex-Headteacher who now runs his own online safety consultancy.

This is something which our cluster of schools are collaborating on so the meeting is being held centrally in **Salisbury at Manor Fields Primary School on Tuesday 1st May from 3.30 – 5pm.**

Unfortunately it is not appropriate to take children along so it will mean people arranging child care should they wish to go. We did try and hold our own online safety evening at our school in the evening back in November but we had such a low response rate that we had to cancel.
