Communication and Language

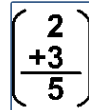
- Anticipate key events in stories

English – including Phonics

- Use phase 2 and 3 sounds to blend for reading and segment for writing.
 - Write confidently in sentences.
- Regularly write common irregular words.
- Read longer texts and able to participate well in guided reading sessions
- Continue sharing and talking about stories.



Mathematics

- Add and subtract two single digit numbers by counting on and back
- Solve problems involving doubling and halving
 - Estimate quantities to 20
- Solve practical problems involving combining groups of numbers



Understanding the World

- Working with age appropriate computer programmes and apps
 - Life cycle of butterflies
- Continue to make observations of our environment



Expressive Art and Design

- Join in familiar songs and rhymes
- Uses simple techniques to shape, assemble and join materials
 - Act out narratives
- Explores colour mixing further
