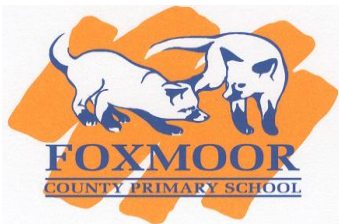

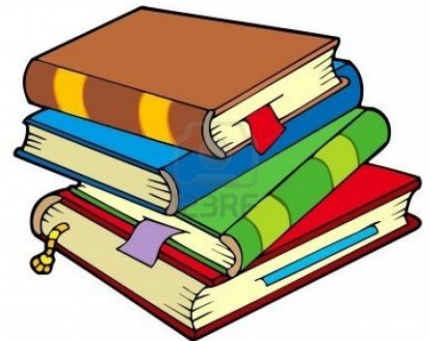
## Church Visits
