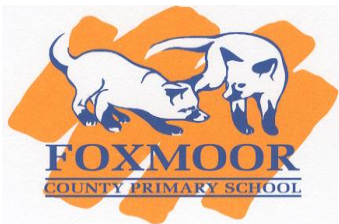

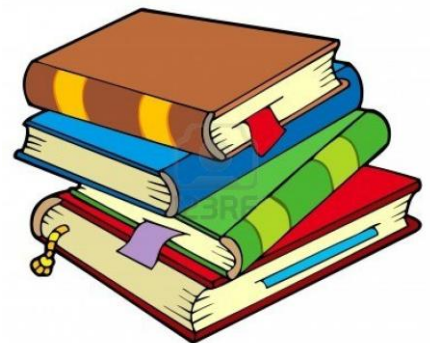
Wear a Hat Day
