



# PE and Sports Grant 2017-2018

## Redhill Primary School

The Department of Education has awarded all state funded schools in the country with primary aged pupils a Sport and Physical Education Grant.

Redhill Primary School's Sport and Physical Education Grant for this academic year 2017 – 2018 is £8,900

During the academic year 2017-2018 all of the children at Redhill Primary School will benefit from the Grant as it has allowed the school to employ a Specialist PE Coach for three days every week who work alongside class teachers, teaching PE multi-skills and a range of sports sessions to all classes across the school. It has also allowed for a sports coach to be employed for after school provision.
