School Opening Times

8:40am – 8:50am: School doors open (Year 1 to 6).

8:40am – 9:00am: School doors open (Reception pupils). The doors are open until 9:00am for Reception pupils to enable older siblings to enter school through their allocated door before their younger sibling is taken to their building.

Late door

8:50am – 9:30am: Late door is open.
