As artists and designers we will:

- Construct junk model houses.

Literacy

As readers and writers we will:

- Play lots of rhyming games
- Explore a range of fiction books about friendship.
- Explore non-fiction books about our bodies.

Mathematics

As mathematicians we will:

- Go on a number hunt and a 2D shape hunt in the outdoor area.
