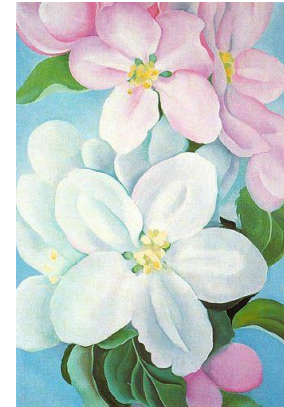

Discover why the Romans came to Britain.

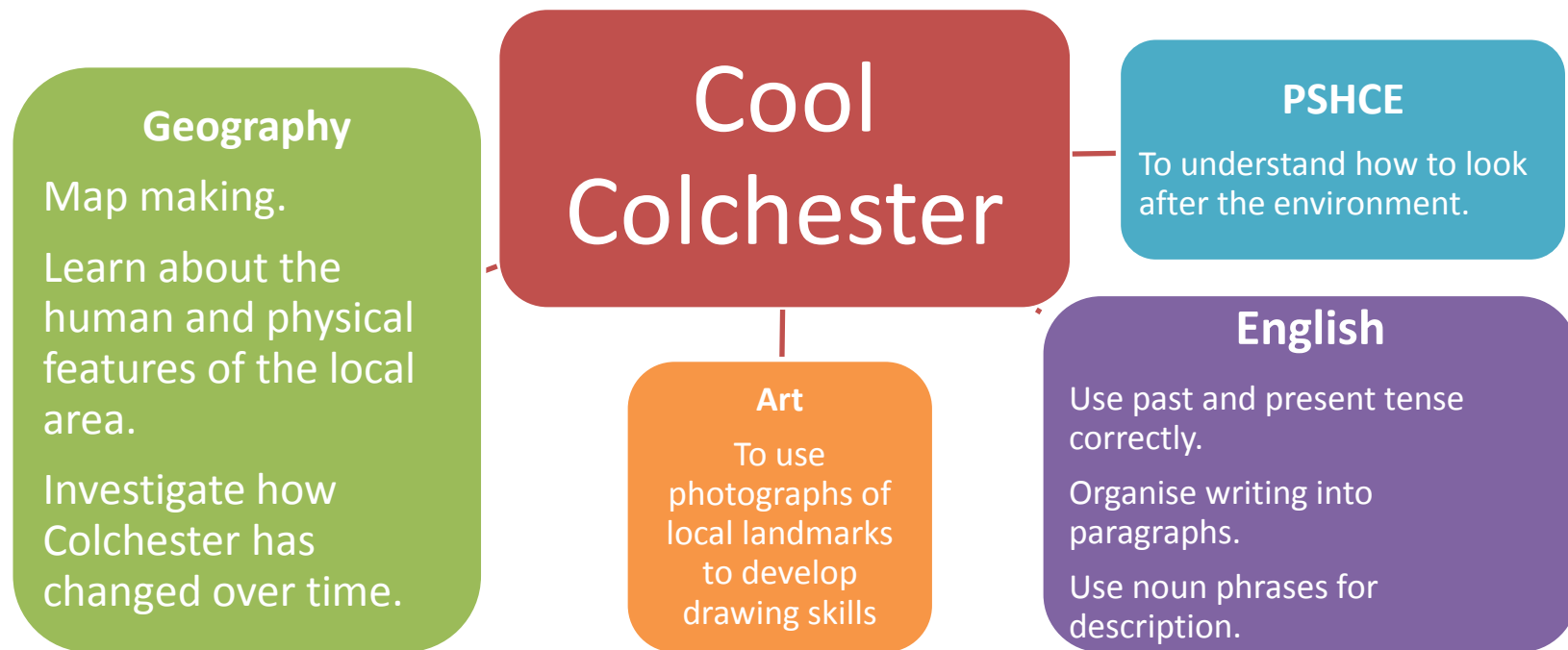
Maths
