



## CHARGING AND REMISSIONS POLICY

The School does not charge for any activity provided as part of the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum.

We currently provide a range of activities and enrichments free of charge including snack, milk, celebrations, events and visitors to support the curriculum. There may be occasions when voluntary contributions are requested dependent on costs.

The following activities are an important part of School life and parents will be asked to make voluntary contributions:

### School outings/trips

The School endeavours to meet the majority of the costs for all outings and trips. Parents will be asked for a contribution to the remainder of the costs.

Parents will be able to pay in full or spread costs over a period of weeks.

Parents who need assistance with payment options should consult with the School who will consider the circumstances.

If we cannot raise sufficient funding to cover the remainder of the costs the visit may have to be cancelled.

### Library

As part of the Home-School Agreement your child will access the School Lending Library. You will be required to sign the Lending Library Contract which states that a £3 contribution will be required should a book be damaged or lost.

### School Fund Raising

The School holds a number of fund raising events throughout the year to extend the children's experiences, contribute to charitable causes and encourage parental involvement.

Money raised is necessary to support the wider curriculum and provide additional enhancements.

Parents are informed of the amount and use of funding raised.

We appreciate any contributions and support for the events.

### Charity

The School contributes to identified charity events throughout the year which are meaningful to the children and support their learning about the wider world. The School welcomes all contributions.
