As a School your trust is important to us so we want you to know that we are in the process of updating our Privacy Notice which explains how we collect, store and handle your personal data. In addition to reflect GDPR we are revising the Images/video consent form and making our Pupil Information Form/annual Data Collection Form GDPR compliant. These will hopefully be coming home in an envelope Wednesday 9th May 2018. Please look out for this envelope and return the 3 forms contained within it by the deadline of Thursday 24th May 2018. If all 3 forms are returned by the deadline date duly completed you will be entered into a FREE draw to win a School Uniform Voucher
