£2,386	Pennine Sports Membership	As we are part of the Pennine Sports Partnership (PSP) we are able to access the facilities of Huddersfield New College. We are able to call upon the knowledge of members of staff from other schools within the partnership which assists in forging strong relationships with other schools and sports teams. We take part in competitions through the PSP and Year 4 are invited to take part in the National School Sports Week as part of the membership.
£3,211	Mr Jordan - After-School Clubs	Mr Jordan is a learning mentor at the school and has extensive experience in specialist coaching for a range of sports. He runs afterschool clubs which ensures we have a range of activities for the children to choose from.
£100	KT Dance / Yoga	We try to offer a range of after-school clubs and in order to do this we have bought in a specialist dance instructor to work with the children and prepare them for the Strictly Pennine Dance event which is held at the Lawrence Batley Theatre each year.
£460	Coach to take 4 classes to Sports Barn.	The event itself is funded however the travel costs are not and we therefore have to arrange and pay for our own transport.
£3,000	Contribution to the mini-bus	The school mini-bus is used to transport the children to and from the sporting competitions both during school hours and after school. This has meant that we can access and compete in a lot more competitions than before.
£295	I Moves	We have purchased a specialist dance program to assist the teachers with the planning of dance lessons. The program can also be used for clubs, wet play etc.
£3000	Laura Foster - Nurse Assistant Practitioner	A specialist practitioner in school once a week to help and support children in various ways.
£60	Duathlon Training	A specialist trainer came into school on Thursday 15 th February 2018 to work with the Year 5 and 6 children that expressed an interest in Duathlon training in preparation for a competition.
TBC	Learn to Ride Scheme Year 3	A specialist trainer will be in school on Thursday 10 th & Friday 11 th May 2018 to work with the children in Year 3 that cannot ride a bike. Initially, they work with scooters and balance bikes to allow the children to gain confidence.
£110.60	T-shirts for Strictly Pennine.	We have a matching set of T-shirts which will be worn for the stage performance at LBT and then used for future sports fixtures.
£84	Medals for Sports Day	Bronze, Silver & Gold Medals for each event winner in Sports Day.
£7,143.40	The remaining balance will be put towards a bid for an all-weather pitch.	We are working with the Sports Partnership on a funding bid to provide the school with an all-weather pitch.
