## SATs Information Newsletter

As SATs approach we thought it a good idea to use the whole of this half-term's newsletter to give you all the information you will need about SATs week.

SATs week runs from Monday 14th May to Thursday 17th May.

### Monday 14th

Spelling Punctuation and Grammar Paper.

45 minutes to complete the paper and it is out of 50

Spelling Test— 20 spellings, no time limit. Takes about 25 minutes to complete.

Both scores then combined to give a final mark.

### Tuesday 15th May

Reading Paper

1 hour to complete the paper it is out of 50.

### Wednesday 16th May

Maths Paper 1: Arithmetic Paper.

30 minutes to complete the paper and it is out of 40

Maths Paper 2: Reasoning Paper.

40 minutes to complete the paper and it is out of 35

### Thursday 17th May

Maths Paper 3: Reasoning Paper.

40 minutes to complete and it is out of 35

All three papers combined to give an overall mark.

- Make sure your child is in school everyday on time. We will be using this time to make sure your child has no gaps in knowledge and to go over things they may have found more challenging.
- Do not overload your child with work, if you plan to revise with them then little and often is best. We want the children full of energy for SATs week.
- Focus any revision on one subject/concept at a time.
- Be positive—your children have worked hard all year and are not going to be nervous unless you are!
- Come and speak to us if you have any questions/concerns.
- Finally, and most importantly, give them plenty of free time to play and recharge their batteries.



## P.E. Kits
