KS1 Trim Trail



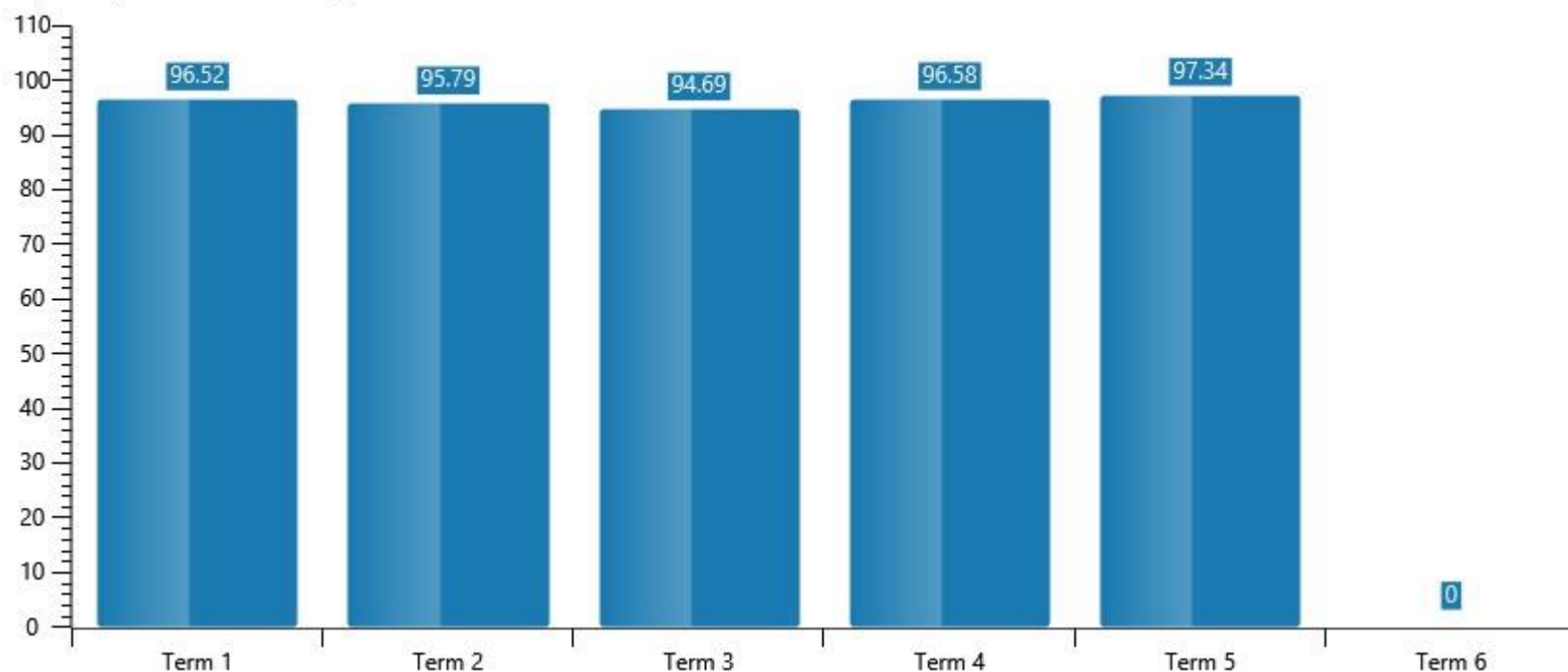
You may have noticed that KS1 have a lovely new trim trail in their playground, the children are already enjoying using this at break time and lunchtime.
