New Build Progress

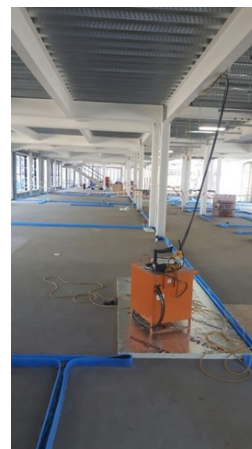
As you can see each time you drive past and from these photos, the new build is coming on now. It is starting to look like a school at long last. We are still on schedule for September 2018.
