## MUSIC TUITION ACROSS THE FEDERATION

The governors and I have just reviewed all expenditure costs across the federation as the new budget for the 2018-19 financial year has been set.

As is the case for all schools, there is increasing pressure on school finances and as you know across the federation, of which Hundon Community Primary School is part, we aim to provide the very best educational experiences and secure the highest educational standards for **every pupil** who comes here. We seek to ensure the National Curriculum is delivered to **all children**, regardless of social background, race, gender or differences in ability. All our pupils are entitled to the development of knowledge, understanding, skills and attitudes, in all curriculum areas, without exception.

It is with this in mind that the existing approach to the provision of music tuition, which currently only a very small number of pupils benefit from, something which had evolved over time, has been reviewed.

With equality of provision for all pupils at the forefront and 'best value' to the benefit of the majority in mind, we have taken the decision to change current music tuition funding in order to look at enhancing the provision of the music curriculum for all pupils, across both schools.

To this end whilst Guitar Club will remain in its existing format until the end of the summer term there will be a change from September 2018.

We are happy to make provision for Guitar Club to continue and for individual pupils to benefit from the personalised music tuition provided but we will be asking parents to cover the cost of these sessions. (This would not affect those pupils covered by our 'Charging and Remissions' Policy which states that parents of children in receipt of free schools meals through eligibility for Pupil Premium Funding are offered the option to make reduced payments and for families where there are other extenuating circumstances, such as family hardship, similar options will be sympathetically considered.)

Should you wish to know more or have questions on this matter it will be part of the next Parent Forum agenda under the heading of Curriculum.

## School Uniform

Just a reminder, Hundon school baseball caps and sun hats are available for £5 from the school office and water bottles are £1.50.

We also have some size 34 jumpers left over from when we stocked uniform at school for sale at £10 each.

Online uniform ordering: Please be advised the final delivery into school will be on the 9<sup>th</sup> of July 2018. Therefore the option for into school delivery will not be available to parents from midnight on the 22<sup>th</sup> of June and will re-commence early September.

Any orders placed after the 22<sup>nd</sup> of June for into school delivery will **NOT** be delivered into school until September.

All parents can choose the alternative method for home delivery for the small charge of £2.95 if preferred. The home delivery service is a 24 hour 1<sup>st</sup> Class, full tracked service.
