My name is Beau Machin and I am six years old. My twin brother and I were born 14 weeks early and we had to spend a long time in hospital. Because we were born too soon, I suffered a bleed to the brain, so part of my brain is damaged. The bit that is poorly is the bit that sends the messages to my legs and hands, so I cannot walk without a frame. Dr Park in America has said he could help me by cutting the damaged nerves in my spinal cord, but I would need to raise LOTS of pennies to get there.

For a bit of fun, we thought it would be good to have a silly boot day. You could decorate your boots, wear odd boots or just wear your wellie boots for a day. I would really like it if you could help me, so I can run around more with my brother and all of you.
